NIGHT WORK ON SPAULDING TURNPIKE IN NEWINGTON SOUTHBOUND LANE CLOSURES SOUTH OF EXIT 3

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation (NHDOT) announces night construction work is planned on the Spaulding Turnpike in Newington.

This work on the southbound lanes south of Exit 3 is planned for the nights of Tuesday, September 9 through Thursday, September 11, 2014, between 7:00 pm and 4:00 am each night.

Southbound lane closures will be in effect between Exit 3 and Exit 1. The southbound lanes on the Turnpike will return to two lanes at the end of each night's work. The Exit 1 southbound off-ramp will remain open.

State Police will be used to alert motorists to the lane closures. The work zone will have a reduced speed limit of 40 MPH in effect, which will be strictly enforced.
